# Get Pampered In Las Vegas Hotels

Known as the city of lights, Vegas in Nevada offers attracting spa services in their spacious and luxurious hotels which will make your stay a luxurious vacation for sure. Relax and experience comfort at its best with the following spas and treatments which will surely make you come back for more.

The Spa located in Encore, one of the newest hotels established by Steve Wynn. The feel of the Asian-Moroccan style covering 60,000 sq foot is really relaxing. More than just a spa, it's also a fitness and beauty facility. The Spa has a lounge for guests to chill while waiting for their treatment. There are cold and warm pools available, waterfall showers, locker rooms, treatment rooms, and bath areas. To finish your exotic experience, you may have facials, massages, and various body treatments like hot stones, aromatherapy and scalp treatment. The 2 outstanding treatments are the Good Luck Ritual and Encore Escape.

Another great spa is Spa Bellagio. It is one of the first sumptuous spa experiences to open in Las Vegas. It has two floors of spa and salon in its 65,000-square feet relaxing atmosphere. The Zen-inspired design makes room for a large layout of 56 treatment rooms, steam rooms, saunas, showers, lounges and more. Its spa is legendary for its Shiatsu massage and Wastu treatment. Some of the other services include facials, wraps, mud baths, peels, massages, and body scrubs.

Qua Baths & Spa in Caesars has a Roman theme to it, with its design full of stone walls and fountains. It is found in the Augustus tower, one of the 6 towers of the hotel. It has about 50,000 sq. feet of pampering ground that keeps the mind, body and spirit in a chilled state. There are 51 treatment rooms, with 35 massage studios, 3 luxury couple suites and 7 facial rooms. Other facilities include hydrotherapy tubs, three Vichy showers, Swarovski crystal body art room, Arctic Ice room, steam, and a sauna if that wasn't enough. If you want to visit Qua, be sure to try their signature hourglass treatment, Qua Signature Bath Liqueur, Mohave Rain, and Arabian Nights facial & body treatment. Except for these, they offer luxurious aromatherapy treatments, relaxation treatment, Roman bathing rituals, massages, body scrubs, and facials.

Spa & Salon Vdara has a nature theme that keeps it feeling calm and simple. Though smaller in comparison to other spas in the area, it feels more intimate. There are roughly 11 treatment rooms aside from the relaxation lounge, saunas, steam rooms, soaking tubs, poo bar, salon, and fitness center. Pay attention to its Pure Results Facial. It's got a nutrition expert and diet advisor for questions about food and health.

The Spa located in the Aria hotel has a complicated and futuristic feel to it, just like the rest of the hotel. It is 80,000 square feet of spa sanctuary with 62 treatment rooms, a spa suite (good enough for 8 people), non-public suite, relaxation and salt meditation rooms, hydrotherapy and Vichy rooms, Japanese stone sauna beds, and a wet area. The most popular service you would not want to miss out is the Thai Poultice Massage. There are other treatments which include shiatsu massage, couples ' massage, Thai massage, facials, and "gabanyoku" treatment. The Spa also has a fitness facility that has classes on Pilates, meditation, Kettlebell coaching, and spinning.

Other spas worth trying in Vegas hotels are The Spa in Mandarin Oriental, Canyon Ranch SpaClub, Sahra Spa & Hammam, Reliquary Spa at Hard Rock Hotel, The Spa at Green Valley Ranch, The Spa at Red Rock Casino, Stirling Club Spa in Turnberry Place, and Aquae Sulis in JW Marriott Vegas Resort & Spa.
