Stuck Overseas? Next Day Lost Passport Replacement Can Be Your Lifesaver

The most important thing for getting your [next day lost passport](#) replacement, is to have a copy of your original passport and two extra passport size photos available. In the event that you are out of your country of origin and do not have your birth certificate with you, a copy of your original passport can serve as your identification. Some people get understandably upset when they lose their passports, but most countries have entities that can assist you with acquiring a replacement. By following their protocol, you may be able to replace your passport quickly.

One obvious step that panicking travelers often forget is to take the time to thoroughly search through their belongings and retrace their steps. It is difficult to search systematically in the grips of panic, so ask a friend to help you. Be sure you have exhausted all possibilities before deciding that the passport has been lost or stolen.

If it is indeed gone, however, contact the local police to file a report. This gives them your name and contact information in the unlikely event that the passport is found and turned in. A report of the documentation loss may also assist you when applying for a replacement or altering travel plans. It is proof of what happened. Also, it never hurts to let the staff at the hotel know you are looking for your passport. They may assist a guest by returning it if it is turned in.

The next step is to contact the nearest embassy or consulate for your country. They will be able to tell you the exact things you will need to bring to apply for a [passport fast](#). Get their address, telephone number and hours they are open. Many offices close on holidays and weekends, so be sure to check their schedule.

The most outside authorities can often do is issue temporary passports good for the length of your journey. The purpose is to complete your trip. Once you are home, you can apply for a replacement passport through the regular channels.

One nice feature of having email access is that it can give you access to a copy of your passport, if you take the precaution of scanning the documents and emailing them to yourself before departure. This removes the possibility of hard copies being lost or misplaced. It is a good idea to carry additional passport photos with you, however.

Having two passport photos available require some planning. A photo can be used for passport replacement when it is two inches by two inches with an unobstructed view of your face against a light background. Remove sunglasses or hats before the photo is taken.

Using these steps many assist you in getting an [rush stolen pasport](#) replaced in time to get to your flight. Once you have returned to your home country, you can follow the regular procedure to apply for a replacement. There are some companies that specialize in passport replacement that may be available if you require additional assistance.
