Tbilisi In Brief

Tbilisi Airport is a contemporary, efficient aerodrome with excellent connections from Europe, the Middle East and Central Asia. Many major cities in Europe are connected to Tbilisi with the Georgia's flagship airline Airzena. Additionally, there are many European network carriers, that operate [flights to Tbilisi, Georgia](#). Tbilisi is linked to the rest of the world via Lufthansa, Turkish Airlines and also other airlines through large networks.

Routes from numerous European cities are additionally available from low cost carriers, like Air Baltic and Pegasus, beginning from 200 Euro both way. Traveling to the city centre from Tbilisi Airport by cab is priced at about 12 Euro. Lower priced options to the city centre are a train link as well as the city bus.

To Batumi, Kutaisi, Borjomi, and many various cities in Georgia, trains are offered. From Baku and Yerevan, there are sleeper trains. By motor coach, it is uncomplicated and efficient to reach a number of other local and foreign destinations.

The choice of mid range and budget hotels is big, with a constantly growing number. Price ranges for luxury accommodations start at 200 USD for a bedroom. While 50-100 USD per night is acceptable for a middle range accommodation, rooms in budget accommodations in the Old Town can already be bookable for 35 USD. An attractive option for backpackers and other individuals on a small budget are hostels in Tbilisi. Often, hostels are situated in little lovely buildings within the city centre. It is easy to stay for one day for as low as 10 USD in a hostel. These are generally an excellent place to get in touch with fellow backpackers, because they are usually designed with a cooking area plus a community room.

Apartments in Tbilisi are another interesting option for tourists. When compared with staying in a hotel, it is actually attractive to rent an apartment, particularly when remaining for a prolonged time. By being able to cater independently and to having visitors, an apartment provides additional versatility. Travelers, who require more than one bedroom while still wanting to live together in the same flat, like parents with kids, will also appreciate condos. Flats are also on the market on daily rates by plenty of agencies over the internet.
